**Frontier Estates – Proposed Student Accommodation at 36- 40 London Road and 2 Latimer Road

I am writing to invite you and fellow members of Friends of Old Headington to a public exhibition to view our new plans for student accommodation on land comprising 36, 38 and 40 London Road and 2 Latimer Road. This follows on from a previous public exhibition we held in October.
