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A new notice has appeared on lamp posts around Ivy Lane regarding the planning application for the redevelopment of the site. In summary it says, 'The proposed development does not accord with the provisions of the development plan in force in the area in which the land to which the application relates is situated.' A deadline of 27 June is given for comments.

Can you offer any insight to this? Does this related to the current Local Plan or the draft for the next period? Is this a major breach of either plan? A technicality? Given the amount of discussion with planning officials and the public consultation last year this would appear to be a surprising development.

If the project is approved what does this mean for any other proposals that come forward that conflict with the local plan? The lack of context or explanation doesn't really help understand this notice.
